TO BUDGET AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS, FROM LEGALLY AVAILABLE NON-AD VALOREM REVENUES, TO REPAY SUCH NOTE; PRESCRIBING THE FORM, TERMS AND DETAILS OF THE NOTE: AWARDING THE NOTE TO **FLORIDA** COMMUNITY BANK, N.A. BY **NEGOTIATED** APPROVING THE FORM OF A LINE OF CREDIT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND FLORIDA COMMUNITY BANK, N.A.; MAKING CERTAIN COVENANTS AND AGREEMENTS IN **PROVIDING** CONNECTION THEREWITH; FOR THF ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
