MINUTES

CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS TUESDAY, OCTOBER 18, 2016 CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS 10001 NW 87 AVENUE

- **1. Call to Order:** Chairman Garcia called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.
- **2. Roll Call:** Present were Chairman Luciano Garcia, Councilman Jorge Gutierrez, Councilman Jorge A. Merida and Councilman Elmo L. Urra. Councilman Rolando Piña. Also present were Mayor Yioset De La Cruz and City Attorney Charles A. Citrin. Councilman Rolando Piña was absent.
- **3. Invocation:** Chairman Garcia gave the invocation.
- 4. Pledge of Allegiance: Mayor De La Cruz led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- **5. Deletions / Emergency Additions:** None were offered.
- **6. Review of Minutes: October 4, 2016.** Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve the minutes of October 4, 2016 seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.
- **7. Public Comments:** None were offered.

8. Proposed Resolutions:

A) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, RELATING TO THE CITY'S UTILITIES SYSTEM REVENUE NOTE, SERIES 2012; APPROVING THE FORM OF A FIRST AMENDMENT TO LOAN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND TD BANK, N. A.; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the resolution into the record. He went on to state that TD Bank had noted that we were not meeting one of the requirements of the loan agreement and it needed to be amended. The amendment would serve to make clear that the City's stormwater revenues are pledged to the repayment of the loan. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.

B) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS APPROVING THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS AND THE POLICE BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2016 UNTIL SEPTEMBER 30, 2019; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF SUCH CONTRACT; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the resolution into the record. Ms. Aida Martinez-Ruiz, Assistant City Attorney, came forward and gave details of the negotiation of the new contract with the PBA. She stated that the contract was mutually beneficial to both parties and that police officers had voted almost unanimously in favor of the contract except for only one vote. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.
