CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS TUESDAY, JUNE 16, 2015 CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS 10001 NW 87 AVENUE

- **1.** Call to Order: Chairman Garcia called the meeting to order at 7:33 p.m.
- 2. Roll Call: Present were Chairman Luciano Garcia, Councilman Jorge A. Merida, Councilman Elmo L. Urra, Councilman Jorge Gutierrez, and Mr. Charles A. Citrin, City Attorney. Absent were Councilman Rolando Pina and Mayor Yioset De La Cruz.
- **3. Invocation:** Chairman Garcia gave the invocation.
- **4. Pledge of Allegiance:** Mr. Citrin led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- **5. Deletions / Emergency Additions:** One item added to the agenda as 8B.
- **6. Review of Minutes: June 16, 2015.** Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve the minutes of June 16, 2015 seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.
- 7. Public Comments: None were offered.

8. Proposed Resolutions:

A) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH TRI-COUNTY ENGINEERING, INC. FOR CONTRACT ADMINISTRATION AND PROJECT MANAGEMENT; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the resolution into the record. Contract with Tri-County Engineering. This is part of the state grant the City received. The Mayor negotiated this contract. Joe Lopez was present. This is a standard agreement with the percentage for project management as required by the State. As Joe is familiar with the City and projects it would be feasible and this be a memorializing action already taken.

B) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, RE-APPOINTING THE MEMBERS OF THE HEALTH FACILITIES AUTHORITY ESTABLIHED FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING ADDITIONAL MEANS TO ASSIST IN THE DEVELOPMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF HEALTH FACILITIES LOCATED WITHN THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the resolution into the record. Citrin stated that the City was approached by the Archdioso as they would like to refinance the bond issued in 2007. This resolution would serve to reappoint members of the health facility board. Motion to approve by Chair second by Merida. Unanimously approved.

9. First Reading for consideration of the following ordinance:

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, A) CHAPTER FLORIDA, AMENDING 78, LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS, ARTICLE IX - "SIGNS," HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, CODE ORDINANCES, SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION 78-173 - "EXEMPT SIGNS;" SECTION 78-176 - SIGN STANDARDS AND REGULATIONS (a) "TEMPORARY SIGNS", BY ADDING A NEW SUBSECTION (8) ENTITLED "BANNER SIGNS" AND PROVIDING NEW REGULATIONS FOR BANNER SIGNS INCLUDING DURATION OF DISPLAY, LOCATION, MAXIMUM HEIGHT, WIDTH, NUMBER, PERMIT APPLICATION, MAINTENANCE AND ENFORCEMENT; AND UNDER ARTICLE X "DEFINITIONS" ADDING THE DEFINITION OF "BANNER SIGN;" REPLACING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN CODE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Citrin read the ordinance into the record. This is a city sponsored ordinance and a first reading and as such public input will be afforded upon second reading. Motion to approve by Chair second by Merida. Unanimously approved by voice vote. **(4-0)**

FEET; THENCE SOUTH 39 DEGREES 00'45" WEST FOR 35.00 FEET TO THE INTERSECTION WITH A LINE LYING 35.00 FEET SOUTHWESTERLY AND PARALLEL WITH THE SAID NORTHEASTERLY LINE OF TRACT "C"; THENCE NORTH 50 DEGREES 59'15" WEST ON SAID PARALLEL LINE FOR 253.62 FEET TO THE INTERSECTION WITH THE NORTHWESTERLY LINE OF SAID TRACT "C" AND THE SOUTHEASTERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF N.W. 138TH STREET; THENCE NORTH 38 DEGREES 58'58" EAST ON SAID SOUTHEASTERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE AND ON THE NORTHWESTERLY LINE OF SAID TRACT "C" AND AFOREMENTIONED NORTHWESTERLY LINE TRACT "Z" OF "SHOMA COMMERCIAL REPLAT" FOR 260.83 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING. Staff recommendations for approval of site plan and variances with conditions. All conditions were addressed except for the unity of title which will follow. Comments regarding parking were addressed. Motion to revise ordinance to include "variances". Open public hearing at 7:52PM close at 7:52PM. Chair made comments regarding height variance. Chair made a motion to approve both "variance" and site plan second by Merida. Unanimously approved by individualized voice vote. **(4-0)**
