MINUTES

CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 22, 2015 CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS 10001 NW 87 AVENUE

- **1. Call to Order:** Chairman Garcia called the meeting to order at 7:31 p.m.
- **2. Roll Call:** Present were Chairman Luciano Garcia, Councilman Rolando Piña, Councilman Jorge Gutierrez, Councilman Jorge A. Merida and Councilman Elmo L. Urra. Also present were Mayor Yioset De La Cruz and Assistant City Attorney Aida Martinez-Ruiz.
- **3. Invocation:** Chairman Garcia gave the invocation.
- 4. Pledge of Allegiance: Mayor De La Cruz led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- **5. Deletions / Emergency Additions:** None were offered.
- **6. Review of Minutes: September 8, 2015.** Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve the minutes of September 8, 2015 seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.
- **7. Public Comments:** None were offered.

8. Proposed Resolutions:

A) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA ENCOURAGING THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE TO REMOVE BARRIERS TO CUSTOMER-SITED SOLAR POWER; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

Ms. Martinez-Ruiz read the full title of the resolution into the record. At this time Chairman Garcia excused himself from the dais and abstained from voting on this item. He then passed the gavel to Councilman Piña who sponsored the resolution which urges the legislature to remove barriers to customer-sited solar power options. Councilman Piña serving as Chairman made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved. Chairman Garcia returned to the dais.

Ms. Aida Martinez-Ruiz read the full title of the ordinance into the record. The applicant was not present. Chairman Garcia stated that this was a first reading and as such an opportunity for public input would be provided upon second reading. He then made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved by individualized voice vote. **(5-0)**

FOLIOS: 27-2019-001-0130 AND 27-2019-001-0121, APPROXIMATE LOCATION: BETWEEN NW 109TH AVENUE AND NW 112TH AVENUE AND SOUTH OF THEORETICAL 150TH STREET, HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR CONDITIONS; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

Ms. Aida Martinez-Ruiz read the full title of the ordinance into the record. Mr. Manny Reus, architect for the project was present. Chairman Garcia stated that this was a first reading and as such an opportunity for public input would be provided upon second reading. He then made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved by individualized voice vote. **(5-0)**

A) ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A MILLAGE RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2015 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2016, AT 5.1613 MILLS, WHICH IS AN INCREASE OF 9.61% OVER THE ROLL BACK RATE SO AS TO PROVIDE THE NECESSARY REVENUE TO MEET THE DETERMINED BUDGETARY NEEDS OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

Ms. Martinez-Ruiz read the full title of the budget ordinance into the record. Mayor De La Cruz commented that the millage rate will remain the same as last year's. The City will be receiving additional revenue due to the County raising its assessment on property values but the City will not be increasing its millage rate. Chairman Garcia opened the Public Hearing at 7:41 p.m. No comments were offered and the Public Hearing was closed at 7:41 p.m. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was approved unanimously by individualized voice vote. **(5-0)**

G) ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE CITIZEN'S INDEPENDENT TRANSPORTATION TRUST FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2015, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2016; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

Ms. Martinez-Ruiz read the full title of the budget ordinance into the record. Chairman Garcia opened the Public Hearing at 7:41 p.m. No comments were offered and the Public Hearing was closed at 7:41 p.m. Chairman Garcia took this opportunity Chairman to congratulate the Mayor once again for his work during the budget process and for all his hard work throughout the years. Chairman Garcia also thanked the department heads in attendance for their work, dedication and leadership in their respective departments which has contributed to the City's success. He asked that each of them convey the appreciation of the Council to their department employees for the work they do day in and day out which elicits all the positive feedback received from the residents of the City. He then made a motion to approve the final, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was approved unanimously by individualized voice vote. **(5-0)**
