MINUTES

CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2015 CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS 10001 NW 87 AVENUE

- **1. Call to Order:** Chairman Garcia called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.
- **2. Roll Call:** Present were Chairman Luciano Garcia, Councilman Jorge Gutierrez, Councilman Jorge A. Merida, Councilman Rolando Piña, Councilman Elmo L. Urra and Aida Martinez-Ruiz Assistant City Attorney. Mayor Yioset De La Cruz and City Attorney Charles A. Citrin were absent.
- **3. Invocation:** Chairman Garcia gave the invocation.
- 4. Pledge of Allegiance: Councilman Piña led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- **5. Deletions / Emergency Additions:** None were offered.
- **6. Review of Minutes: October 6, 2015.** Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve the minutes of October 6, 2015 seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.
- **7. Public Comments:** None were offered.

8. Proposed Resolutions:

A) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS **AUTHORIZING ENTERING** INTO ΑN **INTERLOCAL** MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, **FLORIDA** AGREEMENT WITH REGARDING FILM PERMITTING: **AUTHORIZING** THE EXECUTION OF SUCH AGREEMENT BY THE MAYOR; THE PROVISIONS OF SUCH AGREEMENT; RATIFYING **FOR CONFLICTS: PROVIDING FOR** PROVIDING SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Ms. Martinez-Ruiz read the full title of the resolution into the record and proceeded to explain that the resolution would facilitate filming in the City. The previous interlocal agreement with Miami-Dade county was done five years ago has expired. This resolution would serve to renew the agreement. The film office receives a request for a permit and then notifies the City of which dates filming will occur. After the fact, the City is compensated separately by the person doing the filming. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.

9. First Reading for consideration and final adoption of the following ordinance:

HAVING **RADIUS** OF 25.00 FEET; Α THENCE NORTHWESTERLY 20.51 FEET ALONG SAID CURVE THROUGH A CENTRAL ANGLE OF 47°00'51" TO THE BEGINNING OF A REVERSE CURVE CONCAVE TO THE EAST HAVING A RADIUS OF 63.00 FEET, A RADIAL LINE THROUGH SAID BEGINNING OF REVERSE CURVE BEARS N40°25'09"E; THENCE NORTHWESTERLY, NORTHERLY AND NORTHEASTERLY 150.65 FEET ALONG SAID CURVE THROUGH A CENTRAL ANGLE OF 137°00'51" TO A POINT ON THE EASTERLY LINE OF THE SOUTHWEST ONE-QUARTER (SW. 1/4) OF THE NORTHEAST ONE-QUARTER (NE. 1/4) OF SAID SECTION 19; THENCE S02°34'00"E ALONG SAID LINE FOR 164.95 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING. APPROXIMATE LOCATION: BETWEEN NW 109TH AVENUE AND NW 112TH AVENUE AND SOUTH OF THEORETICAL 150TH STREET, HIALEAH FLORIDA. FOLIOS: 27-2019-001-0130 AND 27-2019-001-PROVIDING FOR CONDITIONS; PROVIDING FOR 0121. EFFECTIVE DATE. (TRC Vote: 5-0; P&Z Vote n/a)

Ms. Martinez-Ruiz read the full title of the resolution into the record. Manny Reus, architect for the project was present and came forward. Chairman Garcia stated that this was a first reading and as such public input would be provided upon second reading. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved by individualized voice vote. **(5-0)**

FOLIOS: 27-2019-001-0130 AND 27-2019-001-0121, APPROXIMATE LOCATION: BETWEEN NW 109TH AVENUE AND NW 112TH AVENUE AND SOUTH OF THEORETICAL 150TH STREET, HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR CONDITIONS; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE. (TRC Vote: 6-0; P&Z Vote 3-0)

Chairman Garcia stated that this item had been tabled at the last council meeting. Ms. Martinez-Ruiz swore in those giving testimony on the item. Chairman Garcia made a motion to remove the item from the table, seconded by Councilman Merida, which was unanimously approved. Chairman Garcia gave details as to review the item, which entails the use of a prefabricated trailer to be placed on the property. Ms. Martinez-Ruiz asked if the motion should be read into the record. Chairman Garcia stated that there was no need for it to be read as it was done so during the previous meeting. Mr. Reus stated that a property was eventually going to be constructed and would like to have the prefabricated trailer on-site for however long the council allows and is open to abide. Chairman Garcia stated his opinion being there was some confusion and so as to not penalize the applicant, motioned to approve the site plan for six months with a temporary trailer in order to confer with staff to reach agreement on use. Councilman Piña asked for how long the trailer would be on-site. Mr. Reus stated that he wanted the trailer there for two years. Until the property is developed, the site would be used for truck parking. Chairman Garcia reiterated that

with six month approval, plans should be started for construction of site. The applicant would have to return before council after six months to ask for continued approval. At that point, the council can choose to approve or deny said request. If approved, applicant would receive another six month extension. If denied, applicant would then have to either come into conformity or remove the structure. Councilman Urra asked if the space was to be rented out. Applicant stated that most of the site was going to be owner-occupied. The rear third (1/3) of the property is to be used for the owner's own business. Ms. Martinez-Ruiz stated that council was willing in good faith to approve six months for the trailer, but that it should be used as a construction office. Applicant said he will discuss with owner. Chairman reiterated that trailers are only allowed as construction offices. Chairman stated that improvement of the site can be considered as part of construction. Legally, the requirement is reached, but applicant only has six months. Chairman Garcia then made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved by individualized voice vote. (5-0)
