## **MINUTES**

CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS TUESDAY, AUGUST 05, 2014 CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS 10001 NW 87 AVENUE

- **1. Call to Order:** Chairman Garcia called the meeting to order at 7:32 p.m.
- **2. Roll Call:** Present were Chairman Luciano Garcia, Councilman Jorge A. Merida, Councilman Rolando Piña, and Councilman Elmo L. Urra. Also present were Mayor Yioset De La Cruz and Mr. Charles A. Citrin, City Attorney. Councilman Jorge Gutierrez was absent.
- **3. Invocation:** Chairman Garcia gave the invocation.
- **4. Pledge of Allegiance:** Mayor Yioset De La Cruz led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- **5. Deletions / Emergency Additions:** None were offered.
- **6. Review of Minutes: June 17, 2014.** Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve the minutes of June 17, 2014 seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.
- **7. Public Comments:** None were offered.

# **8.** Presentation of KAPOW (Kids and the Power of the Workplace) Award: Mr. John Casbarro, President of Learning for Success, Inc.

Mr. Casbarro came forward to thank the council members as well as the City sponsorship of KAPOW and its partner school West Hialeah Gardens Elementary. The City has participated in the KAPOW program for the past 7 years. Mr. Casbarro goes on to explain the significance of the program and the impact it has had on the kids. Mr. Casbarro also thanked Mr. Ruiz and Ms. Anabelle Soto for their coordination of the program and introduced Ms. Gonzalez, Principal of West Hialeah Gardens Elementary. Ms. Gonzalez came forward and also went on to thank the Mayor, Council, and City volunteers that participated this year. Mr. Casbarro then thanked the volunteers that participated this year by name. In addition, on May 20<sup>th</sup> at the KAPOW awards dinner an award was presented to the City and Mr. Casbarro wanted to present the award formally to the Mayor and Council at this time.

At this time Councilman Piña inquired as to the number of variances requested, to which the applicant stated that it was only a height variance. Chairman Garcia stated that this was a first reading and as such an opportunity for public input would be provided upon second reading. He then made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved by individualized voice vote. **(4-0)**.

11. City Attorney's Report: Mr. Citrin stated that he was pleased to report that the negotiations for the off system construction and maintenance agreement on 87<sup>th</sup> Avenue between the State, the County, the City, and the Town of Medley has been completed. Mr. Citrin also mentioned that the City has settled a dispute favorably with the City of Medley with regard to water issues.

- 13. Council Members Concerns / Reports / Board Appointments There was a brief discussion regarding the delivery of council meeting packages to the members. Chairman Garcia mentioned that in the past Council Members would receive complete meeting documents prior to first readings and then they switched to second reading. It was agreed to continue receiving the packages as is. Chairman Garcia also went on to mention that he would be on vacation for the next scheduled Council Meeting.
