MINUTES

CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS TUESDAY, JUNE 18, 2013 CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS 10001 NW 87 AVENUE

- **1. Call to Order:** Chairman Garcia called the meeting to order at 7:35 p.m.
- **2. Roll Call:** Present were Chairman Luciano Garcia, Councilman Jorge A. Merida, Councilman Elmo L. Urra, and Mr. Charles A. Citrin, City Attorney. Mayor Yioset De La Cruz, Councilman Rolando Piña, and Councilman Jorge Gutierrez were absent.
- **3. Invocation:** Chairman Garcia gave the invocation.
- 4. Pledge of Allegiance: Mr. Charles A. Citrin led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- **5. Deletions / Emergency Additions:** None were offered.
- **6. Review of Minutes: May 07, 2013.** Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve the minutes of May 07, 2013 seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.
- **7. Public Comments:** None were offered.

8. Presentation of KAPOW Diamond Award: Mr. John Casbarro, President of Learning for Success, Inc.

Mr. Casbarro came forward to thank the council members as well as the City sponsorship of KAPOW and its partner school West Hialeah Gardens Elementary. Mr. Casbarro goes on to explain the significance of the program and the impact it has had on the kids. Mr. Casbarro also thanked Mr. Ruiz for his coordination of the program and introduced Ms. Gonzalez, Principal of West Hialeah Gardens Elementary. Ms. Gonzalez came forward and also went on to thank the Mayor, Council, and City volunteers that participated this year. Walter Dubon, Parks Director and participant in the program came forward and commended the program which helps expose children to different career opportunities. Chairman Garcia mentioned that the Mayor was out of town but offered on his behalf his appreciation and enthusiasm for the program. At this time awards were given to city volunteers that participated this year. Ms. Gonzalez and Walter Dubon then came forward and presented the award to the Chairman and Council members. A photo opportunity was allowed at this time.

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the resolution into the record. Walter Dubon, Director of Parks and Recreation came forward and gave details of the agreement with ADD Fire for this year's fireworks display. The total cost is the same as last year, waiving competitive bidding as there are few contractors that offer this service and product, as well as the past relationship with this company. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.

B) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, **APPROVING AND RATIFYING** THE AGREEMENT FOR DENTAL **INSURANCE** BETWEEN GUARDIAN AND THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, **PROVIDING FOR** CONFLICTS; **PROVIDING FOR** SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the resolution into the record. Aida Martinez-Ruiz, Assistant City Attorney came forward and gave details of the agreement with guardian for the city's dental insurance. The recommendation was to renew the contract with them, which has been the provider for the past three years. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was approved unanimously.

He then made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved by individualized voice vote. (3-0).
