MINUTES

CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS TUESDAY, May 15, 2012 CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS 10001 NW 87 AVENUE

- **1. Call to Order:** Chairman Garcia called the meeting to order at 7:34 p.m.
- **2. Roll Call:** Present were Chairman Luciano Garcia, Councilman Jorge Gutierrez, Councilman Jorge A. Merida and Councilman Elmo L. Urra. Also present were Mr. Charles A. Citrin, City Attorney and Mayor Yioset De La Cruz. Councilman Rolando Piña was absent.
- **3. Invocation:** Chairman Garcia gave the invocation.
- **4. Pledge of Allegiance:** Mayor De La Cruz led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- **5. Deletions / Emergency Additions:** There were none.
- **6. Review of Minutes: May 1, 2012.** Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve the minutes of May 1, 2012 seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.
- **7. Public Comments:** None were offered.

8. Proposed Resolutions:

A) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR THE CITY FIREWORKS ENTERTAINMENT TO ADD FIRE, INC. FOR THE CITY'S INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION; RENEWING THE CITY'S CONTRACT WITH ADD FIRE, INC.; WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING; APPROPRIATE AUTHORIZING THE **OFFICIALS** EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH ADD FIRE, INC.; **PROVIDING** FOR CONFLICTS: PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the resolution into the record. Mr. Walter Dubon, Director of Parks and Recreation, came forward and stated that the City has a long track record with Add Fire Inc., and is pleased with the service and firework entertainment. Mr. Dubon confirmed that it will be roughly about the same amount as last year and the City expects to have a similar type of show. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve the resolution, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.

9. Second Reading / Public Hearing for consideration and final adoption of the following ordinances:

A) ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, APPROVING A FINAL PLAT FOR TRIANGLE VENTURE SUBDIVISION, CONCERNING PROPERTY LEGALLY DESCRIBED AS: THAT PORTION OF TRACT 33 LYING NORTHEASTERLY OF STATE ROAD S.R. 25 (U.S. 27) LESS THE NORTH 100.00 FEET THERE OF, "FLORIDA FRUIT LANDS COMPANY'S SUBDIVISION NO. 1" IN SECTION 3, TOWNSHIP 53 SOUTH , RANGE 40 EAST, ACCORDING TO THE PLAT THERE OF AS RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 2, AT PAGE 17, OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, LESS THE EAST 200.06 FOLIO: 27-3003-001-0431; PROVIDING FOR FEET. CONDITIONS; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE. (TRC Vote: 5-0; P&Z Vote: 5-0)

Mr. Citrin swore in those who would be providing testimony on the items for Public Hearing / Second Reading. Mayor Yioset De La Cruz commented that this item would have to be tabled due to pending paper work to be submitted by the applicant. Mr Citrin proceeded to read the full title of the ordinance into the record. Chairman Garcia made a motion to table the item, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was approved unanimously by individualized voice vote. **(4-0)**

B) ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 78 ENTITLED LAND USE REGULATIONS ARTICLE VI, TRANSPORTATION, PARKING AND LOADING REQUIREMENTS, TO ADD RATIO OF PARKING SPACES NEEDED FOR INDUSTRIAL USES ENTITLED WAREHOUSE / INDUSTRIAL UNDER SECTION **TABLE** OF **OFF-STREET** 78-141 (b) PARKING REQUIREMENTS; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN CODE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the ordinance into the record. Mrs. Mirtha Gonzalez, Chief Zoning Official came forward and read her memo into the record regarding the creation of new regulations for buildings larger than 10,000 square feet. This is a City initiated ordinance to change stringent requirements for off-street parking in Industrial Areas. Chairman Garcia opened the Public Hearing at 7:41 p.m. No comments were offered and the Public Hearing was closed at 7:41 p.m. Chairman Garcia then made a motion to approve the ordinance, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was approved unanimously by individualized vote. **(4-0)**

- **10. City Attorney's Report** Making reference to his recent trip to Israel, Mr. Citrin stated that one of the most famous cities in Israel is now the City of Hialeah Gardens.
- **11. Mayor's Report Miscellaneous** Mayor Yioset De La Cruz recognized Olga Fulquieras representing Commissioner José "Pepe" Diaz's office. He expressed his gratitude for the Commissioner's help in securing \$60,000 for renovations to the City's Senior Center.
- **12.** Council Members Concerns / Reports / Board Appointments Chairman Garcia stated that he will be out of town for the next meeting.
- **13. Adjournment –** The meeting was adjourned at 7:44 p.m.
