## **MINUTES**

CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS TUESDAY, October 18, 2011 CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS 10001 NW 87 AVENUE

- **1. Call to Order:** Councilman Jorge A. Merida made a motion to select Councilman Gutierrez to serve as Chairman for tonight's meeting in the absence of Chairman Luciano Garcia. The motion was seconded by Councilman Elmo L. Urra and unanimously approved. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m.
- **2. Roll Call:** Present were Councilman Jorge Gutierrez, Councilman Jorge A. Merida and Councilman Elmo L. Urra. Also present was City Attorney Charles Citrin. Councilman Luciano Garcia, Councilman Rolando Piiña and Mayor Yioset De La Cruz were absent.
- **3. Invocation:** Chairman Gutierrez gave the invocation.
- **4. Pledge of Allegiance:** Councilman Urra led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- **5. Deletions / Emergency Additions:** None were offered.
- **6. Review of Minutes:** October 4, 2011. Chairman Gutierrez made a motion to approve the minutes of October 4. 2011, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.
- **7. Public Comments:** None were offered.

# 8. Proposed Resolutions:

A) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS AUTHORIZING ENTERING INTO A MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWN OF MEDLEY. FLORIDA REGARDING LAW ENFORCEMENT ISSUES AND NEEDS: AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF SUCH AGREEMENT BY THE MAYOR; RATIFYING OF PROVISIONS SUCH AGREEMENT: PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS: PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY: AND **PROVIDING** FOR ΑN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the resolution into the record. Chief Toth came forward and reported on the mutual aid agreement with the Town of Medley for law enforcement needs. Chairman Gutierrez made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.

B) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR TO APPLY FOR THE FEDERAL DRUG CONTROL AND SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM GRANT AVAILABLE THROUGH MIAMI-DADE COUNTY TO APPLY FOR, RECEIVE, EXPEND AND AMEND BYRNE/JAG FORMULA PROGRAM FUNDS AND EXECUTE AGREEMENTS WITH THE PURPOSE OF CREATING A RECORDS IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the resolution into the record. Chief Toth came forward and reported on the grant which will serve to expand the Police Departments records improvement program. Chairman Gutierrez made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.

C) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA ELECTING TO USE THE UNIFORM METHOD OF COLLECTING NON-AD VALOREM SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS LEVIED WITHIN THE INCORPORATED AREA OF THE CITY; STATING A NEED FOR SUCH LEVY; PROVIDING FOR THE MAILING OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERALBILITY AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the resolution into the record. Mr. Marcos Piloto came forward and explained that the city is required to hold a public hearing and adopt a resolution of intent to use the uniform method of collection for any assessment program in the calendar year prior to any such collection. The city has met the public notice requirements as per Florida Statutes and the next step will require Miami-Dade County Property Appraisal's office to drat an agreement with the city authorizing the tax collection method for the NW District Special Assessment Improvement Fund. The item was opened for discussion. Chairman Gutierrez made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.

Chairman Gutierrez opened the public hearing for comments at at 7:47 p.m. no one came forward; therefore he closed the public hearing at 7:47 p.m. Chairman Gutierrez made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved by individualized voice vote. (3-0)

B) ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA; AMENDING THE CITY CODE CHAPTER 38 (PARKS AND RECREATION STANDARDS OF CONDUCT) SECTION 28(m) (PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES.... FIREARMS AND FIREWORKS); PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the ordinance into the record and stated this ordinance served to amend the city code for the same reasons as did the previous one. Chairman Gutierrez opened the public hearing for comments at 7:48 p.m. no one came forward; therefore he closed the public hearing a 7:48 p.m. Chairman Gutierrez made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved by individualized voice vote. (3-0)
