MINUTES

CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS TUESDAY, December 6, 2011 CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS 10001 NW 87 AVENUE

- **1. Call to Order:** Chairman Garcia called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.
- **2. Roll Call:** Present were Chairman Luciano Garcia, Councilman Rolando Piña, Councilman Jorge A. Merida and Councilman Elmo L. Urra. Also present was Ms. Aida Martinez-Ruiz, Assistant City Attorney. Mayor Yioset De La Cruz, City Attorney Charles Citrin and Councilman Jorge Gutierrez were absent.
- **3. Invocation:** Chairman Garcia gave the invocation.
- 4. Pledge of Allegiance: Councilman Piña led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 5. Deletions / Emergency Additions: None were offered.
- **6. Review of Minutes:** November 1, 2011. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve the minutes of November 1, 2011, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.
- **7. Public Comments:** None were offered.

8. Public Hearing to Impose and Provide for Collection of Special Assessments.

Mr. Joe Lopez, Public Works Director came forward and informed that this public hearing is a requirement per Florida Statutes and is part of the ongoing process of the proposed special assessment for improvements to the NW District. The hearing allows for participation and comments from the public regarding this matter. Chairman Garcia opened the public hearing at 7:38 p.m. No one came forward therefore Chariman Garcia closed the public hearing at 7:38 p.m.

9. Proposed Resolutions:

A) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA RELATING TO THE PROVIDING OF CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA AUTHORIZED BY CHAPTER 170, FLORIDA STATUTES, AS **MORE** PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED ΙN THE **SPECIAL** ASSESSMENT **ALLOCATION** REPORT; EQUALIZING, CONFIRMING, LEVYING APPROVING, AND **SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS** ON THE **PROPERTY SPECIALLY** BENEFITED BY SUCH IMPROVEMENTS TO PAY THE COSTS THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF THE **UNIFORM METHOD FOR** COLLECTING **SPECIAL** ASSESSMENTS AS AUTHORIZED BY CHAPTER 197, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING FOR COLLECTION OF THE ASSESSMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN OPPORTUNITY FOR PREPAYMENT OF THE ASSESSMENTS; PROVIDING A METHOD FOR ALLOCATING THE TOTAL ASSESSMENTS AMONG THE BENEFITED PARCELS WITH THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERALBITY AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Ms. Aida Martinez-Ruiz read the full title of the resolution into the record. Mr. Joe Lopez, Public Works Director came forward and stated this resolution proports to ratify the last resolution passed creating the assessment, provide for the collection through a tax and allows for a period of prepayment. Chairman Garcia informed, for everyone's benefit, that it seems that we have gone through this process multiple times at multiple hearings but in an abundance of caution the city wanted to make sure that as we go through the assessment process that every opportunity has been given to the public to participate and voice their comments. Chairman Garcia went on to commend staff for all their efforts in protecting the city and its' residents. At this time Mr. Carlos Lerman, part owner of a parcel in the affected area, came forward to speak on the item. Mr. Lerman inquired on when the

assessment would start to be collected and if the improvements were open for changes. Mr. Lopez responded that the improvements which would take approximately 36 months to complete were being analyzed on an ongoing basis as a result of requests from multiple property owners. With respect to Mr. Lerman's parcel, there is a ¼ mile long roadway which fully serves only that particular property. The roadway can be removed from the city's improvement plan allowing the owner to design a complex within their 30 acre property to include internal roads in any fashion they see fit. As for the assessment, Mr. Lopez stated that the tax roll would take effect in 2012. No further comments were offered. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.

B) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE 2011 HOME CONTRACT BETWEEN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY AND THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS FOR THE SAMARI LAKE EAST CONDOMINIUM REHABILITATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE

Ms. Martinez-Ruiz read the full title of the resolution into the record. Mr. Jerry Bell, with Bell David Consultants came forward and explained that this resolution would serve to enter into an agreement with the county for additional recaptured funds to continue the rehabilitation of units in the Samari Lake East Condominiums. The program has been in effect for over four years and these new funds will serve to improve an additional 16 units. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.

Ms. Aida Martinez-Ruiz read the full title of the resolution into the record. Mr. Joe Lopez, Public Works Director came forward for Mr. Marcos Piloto, O.M.B. Director and read his memo into the record recommending the purchase of heavy equipment for use by the Public Works department. The city reaearched the cost of the equipment and is requesting to waive competitive bidding and use an existing Florida Sheriffs Association contract. The city will finance the purchase of the equipment through Sun Trust Bank. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.

Ms. Aida Martinez-Ruiz read the full title of the resolution into the record. Ms. Martinez-Ruiz stated that this resolution would serve to authorize the execution of a lease agreement for the purchase of heavy equipment for use by the Public Works department with Suntrust Equipment Finance & Leasing Corp. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.
