## **MINUTES**

CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 21, 2006

CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS 10001 NW 87 AVENUE

- 1. Call to Order: Chairman Luciano Garcia called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.
- 2. **Roll Call:** Present were Chairman Luciano Garcia, Councilman Elmo L. Urra, Councilman Rolando Piña and Councilman Jorge A. Merida. Also present was City Attorney Charles A. Citrin. Mayor Yioset De La Cruz was absent. Councilman Jorge Gutierrez joined the meeting at 7:37 p.m.
- 3. **Invocation:** Chairman Garcia led the invocation.
- 4. **Pledge of Allegiance:** Councilman Rolando Piña led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 5. **Deletions/Emergency Additions:** None were offered.
- 6. **Review of Minutes:** February 7, 2006. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve the minutes of February 7, 2006, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.
- 7. **Public Comments:** None were offered.
- 8. Request for authorization to negotiate debris disposal services R.F.P. 2006-01: Mr. Marcos Piloto, O.M.B. Director.

Mr. Marcos Piloto, Director of O.M.B. came forward and gave details as to the City entering into an agreement with a vendor for the debris disposal as a result of Hurricane Wilma. He asked the Council for authorization to negotiate pricing between the two contractors who submitted proposals in response to the R.F.P. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.
