MINUTES

CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 19, 2006

CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS 10001 NW 87 AVENUE

- 1. Call to Order: Chairman Luciano Garcia called the meeting to order at 7:39 p.m.
- 2. **Roll Call:** Present were Chairman Luciano Garcia, Councilman Elmo L. Urra, Councilman Jorge A. Merida and Councilman Jorge Gutierrez. Also present were Mayor Yioset De La Cruz and City Attorney Charles A. Citrin. Councilman Rolando Piña was absent
- 3. **Invocation:** Chairman Garcia led the invocation.
- 4. **Pledge of Allegiance:** Mayor De La Cruz led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 5. **Deletions/Emergency Additions:** None were offered.
- 6. **Review of Minutes:** September 5, 2006. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve the minutes of September 5, 2006, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.
- 7. **Public Comments:** None were offered.
