CITY COUNCIL MEETING TUESDAY, JANUARY 18, 2005

CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS 10001 NW 87 AVENUE

- 1. Call to Order: Chairman Garcia called the meeting to order at 7:40 p.m.
- 2. **Roll Call:** Present were Chairman Luciano Garcia, Councilman Jorge Gutierrez, Councilman Jorge A. Merida and Councilman Manuel Zardon. Also present were City Attorney Charles A. Citrin and Mayor Yioset De La Cruz who joined the Council meeting at 7:50 p.m. Councilman Rolando Piña was absent.
- 3. **Invocation:** Chairman Garcia led the invocation.
- 4. Pledge of Allegiance: City Attorney Charles A. Citrin led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 5. **Deletions/Emergency Additions:** Hialeah Gardens Government Complex Parking Area Stabilization Expenditures was added to the Agenda as Item 7A, later changed to Item 8B as requested by City Attorney Charles A. Citrin.
- 6. **Review of Minutes:** January 4, 2004. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve the minutes of January 4, 2005, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.
- 7. **Public Comments:** None were offered.
- 8. Second Reading / Public Hearing for consideration and final adoption of the following ordinances:

Mr. Citrin swore in all those who would be testifying on the item for public hearing.

A) ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, APPROVING A SITE PLAN FOR: 138TH STREET COMMERCIAL PARK INC., CONCERNING PROPERTY LEGALLY DESCRIBED AS: TRACT D SHOMA COMMERCIAL SUBDIVISION, ACCORDING TO THE PLAT THEREOF AS RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 160, AT PAGE 69, OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA. Mr. Citrin read the full title of the ordinance into the record. Mr. Paul Huizenga, the applicant was present. Chairman Garcia opened the public hearing at 7:44 p.m. No one came forward; Chairman Garcia closed the public hearing at 7:44 p.m. A motion to approve was made by Chairman Garcia, seconded by Councilman Merida, and unanimously approved by individualized voice (4-0).

8B. Hialeah Gardens Government Complex Parking Area Stabilization Expenditures: Mr. Marcos Piloto O.M.B. Director

Mr. Marcos Piloto, O.M.B. Director came forward and gave details of the expenditures and requested to waive competitive bidding and use Juner Hauling, Inc. for the material needed to stabilize the parking area at the new government complex. Mr. Jose M. Lopez, Public Works Director came forward and gave additional information regarding the pricing of the material. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida and was unanimously approved. Mr. Citrin was instructed to prepare a resolution to memorialize this action.

- 11. **Mayor's Report Miscellaneous:** Mayor De La Cruz announced the groundbreaking ceremonies for the new police department will be held during the first week of February. Ground breaking ceremonies for the water park will be sometime in February and the groundbreaking ceremonies for the new government complex were held on January 14.

12. Council Members Concerns/Reports – Miscellaneous:

Councilman Jorge Gutierrez thanked Mayor De La Cruz and Mr. Citrin for attending the Samari Lakes hearing.

Chairman Garcia had comments regarding the City's wall and fence height requirements. He requested that a review of the Code be conducted and recommended that changes be made to reflect the measurement of walls or fences be from the final grade as opposed to the crown of the road. Mr. Rey Regalado, Building Director, came forward and gave his input regarding the height of fences and the issue of septic tanks.

13. **Adjournment:** The meeting was adjourned at 8:02 p.m.
