#### **MINUTES**

CITY COUNCIL MEETING TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 15, 2005

## CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS 10001 NW 87 AVENUE

- 1. **Call to Order:** Chairman Garcia called the meeting to order at 7:38 p.m.
- Roll Call: Present were Chairman Luciano Garcia, Councilman Jorge Gutierrez, Councilman Jorge A. Merida, Mayor Yioset De La Cruz and City Attorney Charles A. Citrin. Councilman Rolando Piña was absent. Councilman Manuel Zardon joined the meeting at 7:55 p.m.
- 3. **Invocation:** Chairman Garcia led the invocation.
- 4. **Pledge of Allegiance:** Mayor Yioset De La Cruz led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 5. **Deletions/Emergency Additions:** Baseball League Uniforms was added as Item 14A.
- 6. **Review of Minutes:** February 1, 2005. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve the minutes of February 1, 2005, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.
- 7. **Public Comments:** None were offered.
- 8. State Attorney's Office Community Outreach Division Presentation of programs: Mr. Ulises Martinez, Ms. Gisela Hidalgo, Mr. Luis Martinez.
  - Mr. Luis Martinez of the State Attorney's Office came forward and gave a presentation on various Outreach Programs offered by his office.
- 9. Report on equipment rental and material expenditures for government complex site: Mr. Marcos Piloto, O.M.B. Director
  - Mr. Marcos Piloto, O.M.B. Director came forward and requested that the Council waive the competitive bid process for the purchase of materials and rental

equipment to be used on the government complex project, memos were provided to this effect with details of the cost. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve the drafting of a resolution for the rental equipment, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was approved unanimously. A resolution will be prepared to memorialize this action at the next council meeting.

Chairman Garcia made a motion to ratify staff's action for the purchase of materials from Atocha Trucking, Inc. The motion was unanimously approved. A resolution to this effect will be also be prepared for the next Council meeting.

### 10. Proposed Resolution:

Mr. Citrin read the full title of resolution into the record. Mr. Marcos Piloto, O.M.B. Director came forward and gave a report on the need to amend the annual budget for the General Fund to reflect increases in revenue through a Miami Dade County Grant and a Waste Management contribution. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approve.

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the ordinance into the record. Mr. Paul Huizenga, for the applicant was present. Chairman Garcia stated that this was a first reading and

as such, an opportunity for public input would be provided upon second reading. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved by individualized voice vote (Vote 3-0).

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the ordinance into the record. Ms. Amy Khamissian, for the applicant was present. Chairman Garcia stated that this was a first reading and as such, an opportunity for public input would be provided upon second reading. Let the record reflect that Councilman Manuel Zardon joined the council meeting at this time (7:55p.m.). Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved by individualized voice vote (Vote 4-0).

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the ordinance into the record. Mrs. Aida Martinez Ruiz came forward and gave staff recommendations. Chairman Garcia opened the public hearing at 7:56 p.m. No one came forward; Chairman Garcia closed the public hearing at 7:56 p.m. A motion to approve was made by Chairman Garcia, seconded by Councilman Merida, and unanimously approved by individualized voice (4-0).

C) ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CITY CODE CHAPTER 78 SECTION 308 (WALLS, FENCES AND HEDGES); PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the ordinance into the record. Chairman Garcia gave details for the need to make changes to the City's Code regarding the requirements for fences, walls and hedges. Chairman Garcia opened the public hearing at 8:00 p.m. No one came forward; Chairman Garcia closed the public hearing at 8:00 p.m. A motion to approve the ordinance as amended was made by Chairman Garcia, seconded by Councilman Merida, and unanimously approved by individualized voice (4-0).

- 14. **Mayor's Report Miscellaneous:** There were no comments from the Mayor.
- 14A. **Baseball League Uniforms:** Mr. Arturo Ruiz, Director of Administration/Acting Parks Director.

Mr. Arturo L. Ruiz, Director of Administration came forward and gave a report regarding the need to solicit additional quotes from other providers of athletic uniforms. Chairman Garcia made a motion to waive competitive bidding and return with a resolution to formalize this action, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.

- 16. **Adjournment:** The meeting was adjourned at 8:05 p.m.
