MINUTES

CITY COUNCIL MEETING TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2002

CITY HALL COUNCIL CHAMBERS 10001 N.W. 87 AVENUE

- 1. **Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m.
- 2. **Roll Call:** Present were Chairman Garcia, Council members Rolando Piña, Lucy Valdes, Miguel Haddad and Manuel Zardon.
- 3. **Invocation:** Chairman Garcia gave the invocation.
- 4. **Pledge of Allegiance:** Council member Piña led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 5. **Deletions/Emergency Additions:** No deletions or emergency additions were made.
- 6. **Review of Minutes: October 15, 2002:** Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve the minutes of October 15, 2002, seconded by Council member Haddad. The motion was unanimously approved by voice vote.
- 7. Recommendation on proposals received for Westland Gardens Park improvements: Mr. Ray Garcia, Director, Department of Parks and Recreation came forward and recommended the following proposals:
 - Island Fence of Florida, Inc. for the construction of a backstop and fending for baseball field at Westland Gardens Park. The project cost is \$13,500.00. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Council member Haddad. The motion was unanimously approved by voice vote.
 - Artistic Fence Corporation for the construction of a pre-cast concrete wall along 116th Terrace for the prevention of noise pollution and pest control. The project cost is \$60,720.00. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Council member Haddad. The motion was unanimously approved by voice vote.

Mr. Garcia also requested to waive competitive bidding for the purchase of bleachers and a press box for the baseball field from Miracle Recreation Equipment Co., by piggy backing on a contract with Volusia County. The cost of the equipment is \$57,953.62 and includes a 20% discount off the retail price plus a 3% payment in

advance discount. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Council member Haddad. The motion was unanimously approved voice vote.

8. Request for approval of water and sewer extension agreements between the City of Hialeah Gardens and MDT, LLC, for Maco Commerce Center. (Location: N.W. 107th Avenue and Okeechobee Road): Mr. Al Nielson, Director Department of Water and Sewers addressed the Council and informed that the extension agreements had been reviewed by the Water Board attorney and unanimous approval had been given by the Board. He also stated that current City services would not be affected by the extension. Following Mr. Nielson's recommendation, Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Council member Haddad. The motion was unanimously approved by voice vote.

9. PROPOSED RESOLUTIONS:

A) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A QUIT CLAIM DEED TO THE MACHADO FAMILY LIMITED PARTNERSHIP NO. 3 OF THE LAND DESCRIBED HEREIN EXHIBIT "A" AND TO RECEIVE A QUIT CLAIM DEED OF THE LAND DESCRIBED HEREIN EXHIBIT "B" FROM THE MACHADO LIMITED PARTNERSHIP NO. 3; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE. (Location: N.W. 103rd Street and 87th Avenue and Frontage Rd.)

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the resolution into the record. He explained the issue at hand and the need to take corrective measures regarding lands that were erroneously deeded by both the City and the Machado Family Limited Partnership No. 3. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Council member Haddad. The motion was unanimously approved by voice vote.

B) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN APPLICATION BY THE CITY FOR FEDERAL DRUG CONTROL AND SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM GRANT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO EXPEND MATCHING FUNDS FOR THE PROGRAM GRANT; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION BY THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK OF ALL DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR THIS GRANT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the resolution into the record. Chief Joy came forward and explained that this grant covered a contract award for FY2003 federal funding of \$6,750.00 and matching funds from the City of \$2,190.00. The grant funding will be used by the department's Community Policing program. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Council member Haddad. The motion was unanimously approved by voice vote.

C) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SEEK FROM MIAMI-DADE COUNTY A CHANGE OF STREET DESIGNATION FROM THE CURRENTLY ENUMERATED N.W. 77TH COURT AND REDESIGNATING SAME TO N.W. 77TH AVENUE, PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the resolution into the record. Mr. Citrin explained that this resolution would memorialize action taken by the Council at their last meeting. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Council member Haddad. The motion was unanimously approved by voice vote.

10. FIRST READING for consideration of the following proposed ordinances:

A) ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL, INITIATING AND REQUESTING A PROPOSED BOUNDARY CHANGE OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS FLORIDA, IN ORDER TO ANNEX PROPERTY BEARING THE LEGAL DESCRIPTION CONTAINED IN COMPOSITE EXHIBIT "1", AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CITY CLERK AND OTHER PROPER CITY OFFICERS AND OFFICIALS TO TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO SUBMIT A REQUEST FOR THE PROPOSED BOUNDARY CHANGE TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK TO TRANSMIT COPIES OF THIS ORDINANCE TO THE CLERK OF THE COMMISSION: REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH: PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. Mr. Citrin read the full title of the ordinance into the record. Chairman Garcia stated that this was a first reading and as such, an opportunity for public input would be provided upon second reading; he therefore made a motion to approve, seconded which was by Council member Haddad. The motion was unanimously approved by individualized voice vote. (Vote 5-0)

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the ordinance into the record. Chairman Garcia stated that this was a first reading and as such, an opportunity for public input would be provided upon second reading. Mr. Julio Robaina for the applicant, came forward and requested variances (d) and (h) be removed from the submitted application. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve the ordinance on first reading with the noted changes. The motion was seconded by Council member Haddad and unanimously approved by individualized voice vote. (Vote 5-0)

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the ordinance into the record. Chairman Garcia stated that this was a first reading and as such, an opportunity for public input would be provided upon second reading. Mr. Julio Robaina was present for the applicant. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve seconded by Council member Haddad. The motion was unanimously approved by individualized voice vote. (Vote 5-0)

D) ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS AMENDING THE CITY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES CHAPTER 46 (TAXATION AND FINANCE) ADDING SECTION 46-119 STATE, COUNTY OR OTHER GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY BIDS OR CONTRACTS, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the ordinance into the record. Chairman Garcia stated that this was a first reading and as such, an opportunity for public input would be provided upon second reading; he then made a motion to approve which was seconded by Council member Haddad. The motion was unanimously approved by individualized voice vote. (Vote 5-0)

Chairman Garcia asked Mr. Citrin to swear in all those present who would be testifying on any of the items scheduled to be heard for public hearing. Mr. Citrin read the full title of the first ordinance into the record. Ms. Annette Barrios, counsel for the applicant and Mr. Felix Pardo, architect for the project were present. Mr. Pardo gave a brief presentation of the changes made to the site plan after having met and conferred with City staff, including Mirtha Gonzalez, Chief Zoning official, Joe Lopez, Public Works Director, and Rey Regalado, Building Official. Mirtha Gonzalez came forward and gave her recommendation for approval based on the modifications made to the project. Chairman Garcia opened the public hearing for discussion at 7:58 p.m. Mr. Ben Sedeño, resident of 8390 N.W. 103 Street #101h, addressed the Council with his concerns. No further testimony was offered therefore Chairman Garcia closed the public hearing at 8:00 p.m. and based on staff's recommendation made a motion to approve the ordinance, seconded by Council member Haddad. The motion was unanimously approved by individualized voice vote. (Vote 5-0)

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the ordinance into the record. Mr. Rolando Ortiz was present for the applicant. Mirtha Gonzalez, Chief Zoning official came forward and stated that the application was in compliance with City code. Chairperson Garcia opened the public hearing for discussion on the item at 8:04 p.m. As no testimony was offered, he closed the public hearing at 8:04 p.m. and made a motion to approve which was seconded by Council member Haddad. The motion was unanimously approved by individualized voice vote. (Vote 5-0).

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the ordinance into the record. Ms. Lily Alcazar was present for the applicant. Mirtha Gonzalez, Chief Zoning official came forward and gave her recommendation. Chairperson Garcia opened the public hearing for discussion on the item at 8:07 p.m. As no testimony was offered, he closed the public hearing at 8:07 p.m. and made a motion to approve. The motion was seconded by Council member Haddad and unanimously approved by individualized voice vote. (Vote 5-0).

D) ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS AMENDING THE CITY CODE CHAPTER 78 (LAND USE REGULATIONS) AMENDING SECTION 78-131(7)(d) BUSINESS DISTRICT SPECIAL EXCEPTION USES ALLOWING FOR VEHICLE SALES AND GAS STATIONS (NO MECHANICAL REPAIR PERMITTED); PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the ordinance into the record. Mirtha Gonzalez, Chief Zoning official, came forward for the City. Chairperson Garcia opened the public hearing at 8:08 p.m. Mr. Citrin noted a discrepancy in the ordinance language and asked for the item to be tabled to make the proper corrections. Chairperson Garcia closed the public hearing at 8:08 p.m. and made a motion to table the item. Council member Haddad offered a second and the motion was unanimously approved by individualized voice vote. (Vote 5-0 Tabled).

- 13. City Attorney's Report Mr. Citrin reported on a recent trip to New York made by the Mayor, Arturo Ruiz and himself. He was pleased to announce that the City had made a good showing at meetings with rating agencies, Moodys and Standard and Poors. He also informed that the City would be arguing the charter school special exception use case before the Circuit Court sitting as an Apellate Court. In closing Mr. Citrin made reference to a memo provided to the Council regarding the procedure for appointments to the Police Pension Board.
