- 1. Call to Order:** Chairman Garcia called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.
- 2. Roll Call:** Present were Chairman Luciano Garcia, Councilman Jorge Gutierrez, Councilman Jorge Merida, Mayor Yiozet De La Cruz, and Assistant City Attorney Aida Martinez-Ruiz. Councilman Rolando Piña, Councilman Elmo Urra and City Attorney Charles Citrin were absent.
- 3. Invocation:** Chairman Garcia gave the invocation.
- 4. Pledge of Allegiance:** Mayor De La Cruz led the pledge of allegiance.
- 5. Deletions/Emergency Additions:** N/A
- 6. Review of Minutes: February 4, 2020** Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve the minutes of February 4, 2020, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved
- 7. Public Comments:** None were offered.

8. First Reading for consideration of the following ordinances:

- A) ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS AMENDING ARTICLE V ENTITLED DEVELOPMENT AND DESIGN STANDARDS, DIVISION 4 FOR BUSINESS AND INDUSTRIAL ZONING DISTRICTS REGULATIONS INCREASING THE MAXIMUM HEIGHT PERMITTED WITHIN IN-1 (LIGHT INDUSTRIAL), IN-2 (HEAVY INDUSTRIAL) AND IN-C (CONTROLLED INDUSTRIAL) ZONING DISTRICTS WITHIN THE NORTHWEST DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN CODE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

Ms. Martinez-Ruiz read the item into the record. Mayor De La Cruz spoke on the item. There has been an increase of industrial development in the annexed area, and with it the need to approve the same height variance for each individual development. The City has agreed to raise the allowed height in the Code to meet the industry standard that has been approved for other projects to streamline the process. Chairman Garcia agreed that they touched on this issue at the last meeting in which they approved a variance in the annexed area. This is a first reading; an opportunity for public input will be afforded upon second reading. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The item was unanimously approved by individualized voice vote. **(3-0)**

Ms. Martinez-Ruiz asked the Chairman to allow the City Clerk to enter the legal description into the record as written due to its length. The request was approved unanimously by the Council. Ms. Martinez-Ruiz read the short description into the record. Mr. Adam Rydzewski, architect for the project came forward and stated his name and address for the record. This is a first reading; an opportunity for public input will be afforded upon second reading. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The item was unanimously approved by individualized voice vote. **(3-0)**

9. Second Reading / Public Hearing for consideration and final adoption of the following ordinances:

Ms. Martinez-Ruiz swore in those intending to give testimony on any of the following items.

- A) ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA RELATING TO ZONING; AMENDING THE CITY CODE AND ADDING A SECTION FOR "CANNABIS DISPENSARIES, MEDICAL MARIJUANA TREATMENT FACILITIES, AND INDEPENDENT TESTING LABORATORIES"; AMENDING DEFINITIONS; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION INTO THE CODE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Ms. Martinez-Ruiz read the item into the record. This item was spoken about at the last Council meeting on February 4, 2020. It bans medical marijuana dispensaries but allows the sale of CBD oil products. Chairman Garcia opened a public hearing at

7:39 p.m.; no one came forward. Public hearing closed at 7:39 p.m. No questions or comments from the Council. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve the item, seconded by Councilman Merida. The item was unanimously approved by individualized voice vote. **(3-0)**

- B) ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA BANNING SHORT TERM RENTALS OF RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES; AMENDING THE CITY CODE; AMENDING DEFINITIONS; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION INTO THE CODE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Ms. Martinez-Ruiz explained that this item will continue to be tabled and reviewed until further notice. Chairman Garcia confirmed this item was previously tabled at the last Council meeting on February 4, 2020.

- C) ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF ITS PROMISSORY NOTE IN THE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,000,000, TO PROVIDE A REVOLVING LINE OF CREDIT FOR THE CITY; COVENANTING TO BUDGET AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS, FROM LEGALLY AVAILABLE NON-AD VALOREM REVENUES, TO REPAY SUCH NOTE; PRESCRIBING THE FORM, TERMS AND DETAILS OF THE NOTE; AWARDING THE NOTE TO SYNOVUS BANK BY NEGOTIATED SALE; APPROVING THE FORM OF A LINE OF CREDIT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND SYNOVUS BANK; MAKING CERTAIN COVENANTS AND AGREEMENTS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Ms. Martinez-Ruiz read the item into the record. Mr. Juan Rivera, O.M.B. Director, came forward and explained the context of the item. This is the best proposal for a \$2,000,000 line of credit that was submitted out of five other proposals. The City currently has a line of credit with Synovus Bank. Chairman Garcia opened a public hearing at 7:41 p.m.; no one came forward. Public hearing closed at 7:41 p.m. No questions or comments from the Council. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve the item, seconded by Councilman Merida. The item was unanimously approved by individualized voice vote. **(3-0)**

- D) ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS GRANTING TO FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, AN ELECTRIC FRANCHISE, IMPOSING PROVISIONS AND CONDITIONS RELATING THERETO, PROVIDING FOR MONTHLY PAYMENTS TO THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

At this time Chairman Garcia recused himself from this item due to a conflict; as he is an employee and stockholder of FPL, which leaves the Council without a quorum. Chairman Garcia made a motion to table the item, seconded by Councilman Merida. The item was unanimously tabled by individualized voice vote. **(Tabled 3-0)**

- E) ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL OBLIGATION NOTE OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, IN A PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$750,000; PROVIDING FOR A SUPPLEMENTAL RESOLUTION SETTING FORTH THE DETAILS OF SAID NOTE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Ms. Martinez-Ruiz read the item into the record. Mr. Juan Rivera, O.M.B. Director came forward again and reiterated what he explained at the previous meeting concerning the conditions of the item for the purchase of vehicles for the HGPD. Chairman Garcia opened the public hearing at 7:43 p.m.; no one came forward. Public hearing closed at 7:43 p.m. No questions or comments from the Council. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve the item, seconded by Councilman Merida. The item was unanimously approved by individualized voice vote. **(3-0)**

OF SUCH LOAN; PROVIDING SECURITY FOR THE LOAN AND NOTE, PRESCRIBING THE FORM, TERMS AND DETAILS OF THE LOAN AND NOTE; DESIGNATING THE NOTE AS A "QUALIFIED TAX-EXEMPT OBLIGATION" WITHIN THE MEANING OF SECTION 265(b)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986, AS AMENDED; MAKING CERTAIN COVENANTS AND AGREEMENTS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH; REPEALING ALL RESOLUTIONS OR PARTS OF RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HERewith; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Ms. Martinez-Ruiz read the item into the record. Chairman Garcia stated this item had also been spoken on in the previous Council meeting regarding the purchase of vehicles for the HYPD. No comments or questions from the Council. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve the resolution, seconded by Councilman Merida. The resolution was approved unanimously. **(3-0)**

- B) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) 2020 FORD RANGER XL AND TWO (2) FORD F-150 PICKUP TRUCK TO BE USED BY THE MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT; WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING; UTILIZING AN EXISTING GOVERNMENT CONTRACT AS ALLOWED BY SECTION 46-119 OF THE HIALEAH GARDENS CODE OF ORDINANCES; AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH DUVAL FLEET TRUCK SALES; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Ms. Martinez-Ruiz read the item into the record. Mr. Juan Rivera, O.M.B. Director stated that this purchase is for the Maintenance Department. Chairman Garcia asked whether the expense for these vehicles was already provided for in the budget. Mr. Rivera confirmed and added that these were new additions to the fleet. No comments or questions from the Council. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve the resolution, seconded by Councilman Merida. The resolution was approved unanimously. **(3-0)**
