City of Hialeah Gardens Title VI Program Plan Introduction

Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, or national origin in programs and activities receiving Federal financial assistance. Specifically, Title VI provides that "no person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance" (42 U.S.C. Section 2000d) r

The City of Hialeah Gardens is committed to ensuring that no person is excluded from participation in or denied the benefits of any municipal or county services on the basis of race, color, or national origin, as protected by Title VI.

Information Notices

Record Keeping

The Title VI Coordinator will maintain permanent records, which include, but are not limited to copies of Title VI complaints or lawsuits and related documentation, and records of correspondence to and from complainants, and Title VI investigations.

City of Hialeah Garden Title VI Program Plan Complaints

The complainant may file a signed, written complaint no later than 180 days after the date of the alleged discrimination. The complaint procedures are described in detail herein (see Appendix A).

Each complaint should include the following information:

Full name, mailing address, contact Information (i.e., telephone number, email address, etc.), how, when, where and why you believe you were discriminated against, including location, names and contact information of any witnesses, other information that you consider significant.

The Title VI Complaint Form, (see Appendix B), may be used to submit the complaint information. The complaint may be filed in writing to the City at the following address:

The City encourages all complainants to certify all mail that is sent through the U.S. Postal Service and/or ensure that all written correspondence can be tracked easily. Complaints must be mailed to the Title VI Coordinator no later than 180 days after the date of the alleged discrimination.

All complaints alleging discrimination based on race, color or national origin in a service or benefit provided by the City will be directly addressed by the Title VI Coordinator who shall also provide appropriate assistance to complainants, including those persons with disabilities, or who are limited in their ability to communicate in English.

Additionally, the City shall make every effort to address all complaints in an expeditious and thorough manner. A letter acknowledging receipt of complaint will be mailed within seven days (see Appendix C). Please note that in responding to any requests for additional information, a complainant's failure to provide the requested information may result in the administrative closure of the complaint.

The City of Hialeah Gardens will send a final written response letter (see Appendix D) to the complainant. If the complaint is found to be not substantiated (see Appendix E), the complainant is also advised of his or her right to:

- I) Appeal within seven calendar days of receipt of the final written decision from the City, and/or
- 2) File a complaint externally with the U.S. Department of Civil Rights.

Every effort will be made to respond to Title VI complaints within 60 working days of receipt of such complaints, if not sooner. Once sufficient information for investigating the complaint is received by the City, a written response will be drafted subject to review by the City Attorney. If appropriate, the City Attorney may administratively close the complaint. In this case, the City will notify the complainant of the action as soon as possible. In addition to the complaint process described above, a complainant may file a Title VI complaint with the following office:

<u>Limited English Proficiency (LEP)</u>

The City of Hialeah Gardens has a land area of 4.14 square Miles. According to the 2016 Census Bureau estimates, the City has an approximate total population of 23,837 residents which is composed of 96.8% Hispanic/Latino, 91.3% White, 2.4% African American and 0.4% other races. Of the City's population over the age of 5, 5.2% of residents speak English at home, 94.8% speak Spanish at home. The City provides information in English and in Spanish when it is requested. Residents can request translations of documents that are in English. Most City departments have at least one or more employees that are bilingual and Spanish speakers are accommodated with a translator when requested. The City regularly disseminates information via its website and through the City Clerk's office. The City Title VI Policy and Complaint Procedures is located in the City Clerk's office and on the City's web page in English and made available in other languages as requested. The City educates our staff and contractors on the following procedure (see Appendix F): a. Understanding the Title VI Policy and LEP responsibilities b. How to access Title VI Policy and Procedures via the City's website. c. Document and resolve any language assistance deficiencies d. The procedure if a Title VI and/or LEP complaint is filed.

The City will review LEP procedures annually to determine if modifications are needed to meet language assistance deficiencies.

Public Participation Plan

The City of Hialeah Gardens seeks to engage the public in its planning and decision-making processes. Members of the public may make statements at City Council meetings, which occur the first and third Tuesday of every month. City Council agendas are available for review by the public no less than two (2) days before Council meetings, Notices of ordinances under Council consideration are announced in print in local newspapers.

The City continuously seeks innovative methods to engage the public in its planning and decision-making processes, as well as its outreach activities. Recent outreach initiatives include:

- Public notices in local and county wide newspapers
- City events
- On site posting

Ordinances and resolutions adopted by the City to apply for and utilize Federal and State grant funding are placed on the public hearing/meeting agenda and are subject to public notice and comment procedures.

The City and its records are available to the public and the City welcomes their input. The City's Title VI Complaint Procedure is available to the public via the City's website www.cityofhialeahgardens.com.

Decision Making Bodies

The City of Hialeah Gardens does not have transportation related non-elected boards, councils or committees or similar committees. Therefore, a membership breakdown is not needed.

Appendix A Complaint Procedures

Title VI of the 1964 Civil Rights Act requires that "No person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance."

Any person who believes he or she has been discriminated against on the basis of race, color, or national origin by the City of Hialeah Gardens may file a Title VI complaint by completing and submitting the agency's Title VI Complaint Form. A complaint may be filed no later than 180 days after the date of the alleged discrimination. The City of Hialeah Gardens or its designated Title VI Coordinator will process complaints that are complete.

Once the complaint is received, the Title VI Coordinator will review it to determine if our office has jurisdiction. The complainant will receive an acknowledgment letter informing him/her whether the complaint will be investigated by our office.

The City has 60 days to investigate the complaint. If more information is needed to resolve the case, the City's Title VI Coordinator may contact the complainant. The complainant will have 10 business days from the date of the letter to send the requested information to the investigator assigned to the case. If the investigator is not contacted by the complainant or does not receive the additional information within 10 business days, the Title VI Coordinator can administratively close the case. A case can also be administratively closed if the complainant no longer wishes to pursue their case.

After the case is investigated he/she will issue one of two letters to the complainant: a closure letter or a letter of finding (LOF). A closure letter summarizes the allegations and states that there was not a Title VI violation and that the case will be closed. An LOF summarizes the allegations and the interviews regarding the alleged incident, and explains whether any disciplinary action, additional training of the staff member or other action will occur.

If the complainant wishes to appeal the decision, he/she has 10 business days after the date of the LOF to do so.

Apéndice A Procedimientos de quejas

El Título VI de la Ley de Derechos Civiles de 1964 requiere que "Ninguna persona en los Estados Unidos, por motivos de raza, color u origen nacional, sea excluida de la participación en, se le nieguen los beneficios de, o sea sometida a discriminación bajo cualquier programa o actividad que recibe asistencia financiera federal ".

Cualquier persona que crea que ha sido discriminada por motivos de raza, color u origen nacional por la Ciudad de Hialeah Gardens puede presentar una queja de Título VI completando y enviando el Formulario de Quejas del Título VI de la agencia. Una queja se puede presentar a más tardar 180 días después de la fecha de la supuesta discriminación. La Ciudad de Hialeah Gardens o su Coordinador designado del Título VI procesarán las quejas que estén completas.

Una vez que se recibe la queja, el Coordinador del Título VI la revisará para determinar si nuestra oficina tiene jurisdicción. El demandante recibirá una carta de acuse de recibo en la que se le informará si la oficina investigará la queja.

La ciudad tiene 60 días para investigar la queja. Si se necesita más información para resolver el caso, el Coordinador del Título VI de la Ciudad puede comunicarse con el demandante. El demandante tendrá 10 días hábiles desde la fecha de la carta para enviar la información solicitada al investigador asignado al caso. Si el demandante no se pone en contacto con el investigador o no recibe la información adicional dentro de los 10 días hábiles, el Coordinador del Título VI puede cerrar administrativamente el caso. Un caso también puede ser cerrado administrativamente si el demandante ya no desea continuar con su caso.

Después de que se investiga el caso, él / ella emitirá una de las siguientes dos cartas al demandante: una carta de cierre o una carta de hallazgo (LOF). Una carta de cierre resume las alegaciones y establece que no hubo una violación del Título VI y que el caso se cerrará. Un LOF resume las acusaciones y las entrevistas sobre el presunto incidente y explica si se producirá alguna acción disciplinaria, capacitación adicional del miembro del personal u otra acción.

Si el demandante desea apelar la decisión, tiene 10 días hábiles después de la fecha del LOF para hacerlo.
