CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS TUESDAY, March 20, 2024 CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS 10001 NW 87 AVENUE

- **1. Call to Order:** Chairman Luciano Garcia called the meeting to order at 7:33 p.m.
- **2. Roll Call:** Present were Councilman Elmo Urra, Councilman Jorge Gutierrez, Councilman Jorge Merida, Councilman Rolando Piña, Chairman Luciano Garcia, and Ms. Aida Martinez-Ruiz, City Attorney. Mayor Yioset De La Cruz was absent.
- **3. Invocation:** Chairman Garcia gave the invocation.
- **4. Pledge of Allegiance:** Ms. Martinez-Ruiz led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- **5. Deletions/Emergency Additions:** Item 8F was added to the agenda.
- **6. Review of Minutes: February 20, 2024** Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve the minutes of **February 20, 2024**. The motion was approved unanimously.

8. Proposed Resolutions:

A) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING ENTERING INTO A MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA REGARDING LAW ENFORCEMENT ISSUES AND NEEDS; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF SUCH AGREEMENT BY THE MAYOR; RATIFYING THE PROVISIONS OF SUCH AGREEMENT; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Ms. Martinez-Ruiz read the item into the record. This is a renewal of a mutual aid agreement that the City has had [with the City of Doral] for years. There were no further comments. The Chair made a motion to approve the item, seconded by Councilman Merida. The item was approved unanimously. **(5-0)**

B) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, DESIGNATING THE PORTION OF THE CITY FACILITY LOCATED AT 13501 NW 107 AVENUE DEPICTED IN ATTACHED EXHIBIT "A" AS THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS ACTIVE SHOOTER AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE TRAINING FACILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Ms. Martinez-Ruiz read the item into the record. Captain Freddy Caceres, of the Police Department, came forward on behalf of Chief Luis Diaz to seek approval to designate the location at 13501 NW 107 Avenue as the "Hialeah Gardens Active Shooter and Emergency Response Training Facility." There were no further comments. The Chair made a motion to approve the item, seconded by Councilman Merida. The item was approved unanimously. **(5-0)**

C) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR THE CITY FIREWORKS ENTERTAINMENT TO EXCELLENT ENTERTAINMENT, INC. D/B/A ADD FIRE ("ADD FIRE") FOR THE CITY'S INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION; RENEWING THE CITY'S CONTRACT WITH ADD FIRE; WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING; AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH ADD FIRE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Ms. Martinez-Ruiz read the item into the record. Mr. Walter Dubon, Director of Parks & Recreation, came forward and explained that the item before the Council is for the annual 4th of July fireworks show. Everything in the contract is the same

as the previous year. There were no further comments. The Chair made a motion to approve the item, seconded by Councilman Merida. The item was approved unanimously. **(5-0)**

D) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) 2023 FORD F-150 PICKUP TRUCKS TO BE USED BY THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT; WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING; UTILIZING AN EXISTING GOVERNMENT CONTRACT AS ALLOWED BY SECTION 46-121 OF THE HIALEAH GARDENS CODE OF ORDINANCES; AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH GARBER FLEET SALES; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Ms. Martinez-Ruiz read the item into the record. Mr. Walter Dubon, Director of Parks & Recreation, came forward and stated that these two vehicles are budgeted for at a cost of \$79,684.00. The vehicles are both a replacement and an addition to the fleet. There were no further comments. The Chair made a motion to approve the item, seconded by Councilman Merida. The item was approved unanimously. **(5-0)**

E) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A GRAPPLER TRUCK TO BE USED BY THE MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT; UTILIZING AN EXISTING GOVERNMENT CONTRACT AS ALLOWED BY SECTION 46-121 OF THE HIALEAH GARDENS CODE OF ORDINANCES; AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH RECHTIEN INTERNATIONAL TRUCKS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Ms. Martinez-Ruiz read the item into the record. A memorandum from the Maintenance Department seeking approval for this purchase was then read into the record. The truck will be purchased utilizing the Florida's Sheriff's Bid and the cost has been accounted for in the General Fund. There were no further comments. The Chair made a motion to approve the item, seconded by Councilman Merida. The item was approved unanimously. **(5-0)**

F) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE SIGNING AND SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS AND ASSURANCES TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 CONGRESSIONAL APPROPRIATIONS COMMUNITY PROJECT FUNDING FOR CJS-

COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES TECHNOLOGY & EQUIPMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING HIGH-PRIORITY POLICE PATROL VEHICLES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Ms. Martinez-Ruiz read the item into the record. Captain Freddy Caceres, of the Police Department, came forward on behalf of Chief Luis Diaz once again. He thanked the Council for adding this item to the agenda at the last minute. The grant will cover 30 patrol vehicles at a cost of \$51,598.00 each. The grant is going to total \$1,547,000. This will replace a portion of the patrol vehicle fleet. The grant is being requested through the office of Congressman Mario Diaz-Balart for Community Project Funding CJS- Community Oriented Policing Servies Technology and Equipment. Chairman Garcia asked when they would know if the grant is approved. Captain Caceres said it would take about a year. There were no further comments. The Chair made a motion to approve the item, seconded by Councilman Merida. The item was approved unanimously. **(5-0)**
