### **MINUTES**

# CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS TUESDAY, March 19, 2019 CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS 10001 NW 87 AVENUE

- **1. Call to Order:** Chairman Luciano Garcia called the meeting to order at 7:33 p.m.
- **2. Roll Call:** Present were Councilman Elmo Urra, Councilman Jorge Gutierrez, Councilman Jorge Merida, Chairman Luciano Garcia, City Attorney Charles Citrin. Councilman Rolando Piña and Mayor Yioset De La Cruz were absent.
- **3. Invocation:** Chairman Garcia gave the invocation.
- **4. Pledge of Allegiance:** City Attorney Citrin led the pledge of allegiance.
- **5. Deletions/Emergency Additions:** None were offered.
- **6. Review of Minutes: March 05, 2019** Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve the minutes of March 05, 2019, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.
- **7. Public Comments:** None were offered.

## 8. Proposed Resolutions:

A) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT THE CITY FIREWORKS ENTERTAINMENT EXCELLENT ENTERTAINMENT, INC. D/B/A ADD FIRE ("ADD FIRE") FOR THE CITY'S INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION; RENEWING THE CITY'S CONTRACT WITH **ADD** COMPETITIVE FIRE; WAIVING BIDDING: AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE OFFICIALS EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH ADD FIRE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Citrin read the item into the record. Mr. Walter Dubon, Parks & Recreation Director, explained that this is for the City's annual 4<sup>th</sup> of July fireworks show. The City has contracted with this company for 14 years, the scope of the work is the same, and the terms will remain the same. No comments were offered. The Chair made a motion to approve the resolution, seconded by Councilman Merida. The item was approved unanimously. **(4-0)** 

B) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT TO BE PLACED AT A CITY PARK LOCATED 102<sup>ND</sup> AVENUE AND 128<sup>TH</sup> TERRACE USED BY THE PARKS DEPARTMENT; UTILIZING AN EXISTING GOVERNMENT CONTRACT AS ALLOWED BY SECTION 46-119 OF THE HIALEAH **GARDENS** CODE OF ORDINANCES; AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH MIRACLE RECREATION CO.; **PROVIDING** FOR **CONFLICTS:** EQUIPMENT, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Citrin read the item into the record. Mr. Dubon came forward once again and read his memo concerning the item into the record. On August 4, 2018 a vehicle crashed into the City's Tot Lot Park destroying the playground equipment on the property. The Parks Department intends to purchase new equipment to replace the playground. Ms. Aida Martinez-Ruiz, Assistant City Attorney, came forward and explained that the playground equipment had not been insured under the FMIT insurance with the Florida League of Cities. The individual at fault for the crash was arrested, but has the most minimal insurance coverage which will not cover the cost of replacement therefore it was determined that it would not economically feasible for the City to file a claim. The City has now taken an inventory to make sure to

cover *all* types of City equipment and was able to do so at a reasonable rate. No other comments were offered. The Chair made a motion to approve the resolution, seconded by Councilman Merida. The item was approved unanimously. **(4-0)** 

C) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) 2019 FORD F-150 PICKUP TRUCK AND ONE (1) 2019 FORD F-250 FORD PICKUP TRUCK FOR THE USE OF THE WATER AND SEWER DEPARTMENT; WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING; UTILIZING AN EXISTING GOVERNMENT CONTRACT; AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH DUVAL FORD, LCC; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Citrin read the item into the record. Chairman Garcia made a motion to table the item, seconded by Councilman Merida. The item was unanimously tabled. (4-0)

A CHORD DISTANCE OF 34.63 FEET, A RADIUS OF 25.00 FEET AND A CENTRAL ANGLE OF 87°40'42"; THENCE NORTHWESTERLY ALONG THE ARC OF SAID CURVE A DISTANCE OF 38.26 FEET TO THE POINT OF TANGENCY, SAID POINT BEING ON A LINE THAT IS PARALLEL WITH AND 40.00 FEET EAST OF SAID WEST LINE OF THE NW 1/4 OF SECTION 29; THENCE N 02°38'07" W ALONG SAID WEST LINE FOR 528.79 FEET; THENCE N 89°41'22" E FOR 164.72 FEET; THENCE IN A SOUTHERLY DIRECTION WITH A NON TANGENT CURVE LEADING TO THE LEFT HAVING FOR ITS ELEMENTS A CHORD BEARING OF S 09°46'36" W, A CHORD DISTANCE OF 205.20 FEET, A RADIUS OF 199.97 FEET AND A CENTRAL ANGLE OF 61°44'06"; THENCE ALONG THE ARC OF SAID CURVE FOR 215.47 FEET TO A NON TANGENT POINT; THENCE S 88°36'22" E FOR 58.39 FEET; THENCE S 05°21'43" W FOR 163.68 FEET; THENCE S 86°50'51" W FOR 29.80 FEET; THENCE S 41°50'47" W FOR 26.62 FEET; THENCE S 02°41'14" E FOR 47.58 FEET; THENCE S 30°24'13" E FOR 37.45 FEET; THENCE S 02°38'07" E FOR 84.62 FEET, TO A POINT ON A LINE PARALLEL WITH AND 30.00 FEET NORTH OF THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID TRACT 29; THENCE S 89°41'11" W, ALONG SAID LINE, FOR 101.10 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING 74281.57 SQUARE FEET OR 1.705 ACRES MORE OR LESS, FOLIO: 27-2029-001-0306, APPROXIMATE LOCATION: NORTHEAST CORNER OF INTERSECTION OF NW 107TH AVENUE AND NW 134TH STREET, HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR CONDITIONS: PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.
