MINUTES

CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS TUESDAY, November 20, 2018 CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS 10001 NW 87 AVENUE

- **1. Call to Order:** Councilman Rolando Piña, serving as Chairman, called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.
- **2. Roll Call:** Present were Councilman Elmo Urra, Councilman Jorge Gutierrez, Councilman Merida, Councilman Piña serving as Chairman, Mayor De La Cruz, and Assistant City Attorney Aida Martinez.
- **3. Invocation:** Councilman Gutierrez gave the invocation.
- **4. Pledge of Allegiance:** Mayor De La Cruz led the pledge of allegiance.
- **5. Deletions/Emergency Additions:** None were offered
- **6. Review of Minutes: November 6, 2018** Chairman Piña made a motion to approve the minutes of November 6, 2018. The motion was unanimously approved.
- **7. Public Comments:** None were offered

8. Proposed Resolutions:

A) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE ENTERING INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT WITH MANNY DIAZ JR., FOR RENTAL OF OFFICE SPACE IN THE HIALEAH GARDENS CITY HALL; AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH SENATOR DIAZ; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Ms. Aida Martinez-Ruiz read the item into the record. Mayor De La Cruz spoke and explained that this is the same office Mr. Diaz was occupying as a State Representative and will now be occupying as a State Senator. The lease is for a four year period until December 2022.

Councilman Luciano Garcia entered the meeting at 7:35 p.m. At this time a motion was made by Councilman Gutierrez to allow Councilman Piña to remain as Chairman for this meeting. The motion was unanimously approved.

Chairman Piña proceeded and made a motion to approve the resolution, seconded by Councilman Merida. The resolution was unanimously approved.

B) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA AMENDING THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, THE CITY OF HIALEAH, THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS AND THE MIAMI-DADE EXPRESSWAY AUTHORITY (MDX) FOR NW 107TH AVENUE BETWEEN NW 138TH STREET AND NW 170TH STREET; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Ms. Martinez-Ruiz read the item into the record. She explained that this was an agreement that the City had entered into with the above mentioned government entities in order to secure certain tracts of land to be able to extend N.W. 107th Avenue. The Mayor negotiated with the County and the City has amended the original agreement to reflect that the County will now be responsible for securing the tracts of land that are needed to complete the project. Chairman Piña asked if there were any questions or comments from the Council members. There were none. Chairman Piña made a motion to approve the resolution, seconded by Councilman Merida. The resolution was unanimously approved.
