MINUTES

CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS TUESDAY, November 7, 2017 CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS 10001 NW 87 AVENUE

- 1. Call to Order: Chairman Garcia called the meeting to order at 7:32 p.m.
- **2. Roll Call:** Present were Chairman Luciano Garcia, Councilman Jorge A. Merida, Councilman Elmo L. Urra, City Attorney Charles A. Citrin and Mayor Yioset De La Cruz. Councilman Rolando Piña and Councilman Jorge Gutierrez were absent.
- **3. Invocation:** Chairman Garcia gave the invocation.
- **4. Pledge of Allegiance:** Mayor De La Cruz led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- **5. Deletions/Emergency Additions**: None were offered.
- **6. Review of Minutes: October 3, 2017** Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve the minutes of October 3, 2017. The motion was approved unanimously.
- **7. Public Comments:** No public comments.

8. Request for approval of transfer of 2 COP alcohol beverage license for Las Delicias Café, Inc., located at 8725 N.W. 117 Street #12, Hialeah Gardens, Florida. Owner: Mr. Carlos Morales Perdiz.

Mr. Carlos Morales Perdiz, the applicant was present. Mr. Robert Lorenzo Director of the Business License Tax Department came forward and read staff's recommendation to approve the transfer of the 2COP alcohol beverage license into the record. Based on staff recommendation Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was approved unanimously.

9. Request for approval of 2 COP alcohol beverage license for Latin American Food & Pizza, LLC, located at 11093 N.W. 138 Street #124, Hialeah Gardens, Florida, Owner: Mr. John A. Borrego.

Mr. John Borrego, the applicant was present. Mr. Robert Lorenzo Director of the Business License Tax Department came forward and read staff's recommendation to approve the 2COP alcohol beverage license into the record. Based on staff recommendation Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was approved unanimously.

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the resolution into the record. Mr. Andres Delgado, Director of the Water & Sewer Department was present. Mayor De La Cruz took this opportunity to state that the purchase of the vehicle is for the use of the Water & Sewer Department and that the funds had been appropriated in the W&S budget. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.

B) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) 2017 FORD EXPLORER SPORTS UTILITY VEHICLES: WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING; UTILIZING AN EXISTING GOVERNMENT CONTRACT AS ALLOWED BY SECTION 46-119 OF THE HIALEAH GARDENS CODE OF ORDINANCES; AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH DUVAL FORD, LLC IN THE AMOUNT OF \$58,222.00; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the resolution into the record. Mr. Juan Rivera, O.M.B. Director came forward and gave details of the purchase for the two vehicles to be used by the Planning and Zoning and Code Compliance Departments. Funds for the purchase had been appropriated in the corresponding budgets. Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.

C) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS IN THE CENTRAL DISTRICT OF HIALEAH GARDENS; INSTRUCTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS FOR THIS PURPOSE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the resolution into the record. Mr. Joe Lopez, Public Works Director came forward and reported that funds had been provided to the City in the 2017-2018 State General Appropriations Act under Line Item 1606A in the amount of \$1,200,000 for drainage improvements for the central district of the City. Funding for the project is made available through a cost reimbursement grant requiring a grant agreement with the Department of Environmental Protection. Mr. Lopez went on to give the locations where the primarily drainage improvements will be made beginning in 2018. The City would have three years to execute the project. Mr. Citrin took this opportunity to commend Mayor De La Cruz on his hard work in securing this grant. He added that the Mayor's efforts are sometimes taken for granted and that he knows that the Mayor is constantly working to improve the City. Chairman Garcia reiterated Mr. Citrin's comments and added that the Mayor, by maximizing his relationships in the County and all across the State, goes above and beyond to fight on behalf

of the City and its residents. Chairman Garcia then made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.

D) RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH GARDENS, FLORIDA, CO-DESIGNATING THAT PORTION OF NW 107TH AVENUE FROM NW 138TH STREET SOUTH TO OKEECHOBEE ROAD AS "BRIGADE 2506 BOULEVARD"; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the resolution into the record. Mayor De La Cruz stated that the City is co-sponsoring a County resolution to name a portion of N.W. 107th Street / Brigade 2506 Boulevard. The Mayor also mentioned that he believes there will be an official street naming ceremony on or about November 18^{th.} Chairman Garcia made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved.

Mr. Citrin read the full title of the ordinance into the record. Mr. Joe Lopez, Public Works Director came forward and noted that this follows a State modeled ordinance which ties into requirements by the Florida Building Code. Chairman Garcia stated that this was a first reading and as such an opportunity for public input would be provided upon second reading. He then made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The ordinance was approved by individualized voice vote. (3-0)

Mr. Citrin swore in those individuals who would be providing testimony on the item for Second Reading/ Public Hearing. He then read the full title of the ordinance into the record. Mr. Gilberto Pastoriza, attorney of record for the applicant, Machado Family Ltd., was present. Mr. Joe Lopez, Public Works Director came forward on behalf of Mrs. Mirtha Gonzalez, Chief Zoning Official, and read staff's recommendation for approval into the record. The land use amendment to the Comprehensive Plan was requested for a project to construct a maximum of 100 dwelling units for the elderly. There were no objections to the application after review from the Department of Economic Opportunity (DOE), other than a comment relating to defining characteristics or standards of the term "elderly" which was addressed by staff. Chairman Garcia inquired if the property would be privately owned. Mr. Pastoriza responded that it would be privately owned and managed. He added that the applicant had submitted months ago to the city a covenant, running with the land, that required this property to be developed for the elderly with a 100 unit limitation. Chairman Garcia opened the Public Hearing at 8:02 p.m., no one came forward and he closed the Public Hearing at 8:02 p.m. Chairman Garcia proceeded to make a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Merida. The motion was unanimously approved by individualized voice vote. (3-0)
